AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to revenue and taxation; amending Section 59, Chapter 345, O.S.L. 1996 (68 O.S. Supp. 1997, Section 500.59), which relates to the impoundment, seizure and sale of vehicles and cargo violating Motor Fuel Tax Code; updating statutory references; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 59, Chapter 345, O.S.L. 1996 (68 O.S. Supp. 1997, Section 500.59), is amended to read as follows:

Section 500.59 If a person is found operating a motor vehicle in violation of the shipping paper requirements in Sections ~~45, 49, 50 and 55~~ 500.45, 500.49, 500.50 and 500.55 of this ~~act~~ title, the vehicle and its cargo is subject to impoundment, seizure, and subsequent sale and forfeiture, in accordance with the general laws of this state respecting seizure and forfeiture. The failure of the operator of a motor vehicle to have on board, when loaded, the proper shipping papers with a destination state machine-printed on its face pursuant to Section ~~45~~ 500.45 of this ~~act~~ title or which fails to meet the descriptive annotation requirements of Sections ~~49, 50 and 56~~ 500.49, 500.50 and 500.56 of this ~~act~~ title, if

applicable, shall be presumptive evidence of a violation sufficient to warrant impoundment and seizure of the vehicle and its cargo.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1998.
