AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to criminal procedure; creating a uniform probation form for supervised probation; providing contents; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 990.1 of Title 22, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

When a court places an offender on supervised probation, the following form or a form that contains all of the provisions of said form shall be completed and a copy shall be given to the probationer:

am placed on unsupervised status by the Court or Department of Corrections.

9. I will refrain from violation of any City, State or Federal laws including Tribal Jurisdiction. I will advise my officer within forty-eighty (48) hours if I am questioned or arrested by any branch of the government or any of its representatives.

10. I understand that at any time or place I am subject to search by the Department of Corrections. In addition, my vehicle and property under my control are subject to search, should a representative deem it necessary.

11. I will pay a supervision fee of up to Forty Dollars (\$40.00) per month to the Department of Corrections by cashier's check, money order, or electronic transfer. I understand that a service charge may be required by some methods of payment, and that the service charge will be in addition to the supervision fee. Any partial or full waiver of the supervision fee will be made at the discretion of the Probation Officer.

12. I hereby waive extradition to the State of Oklahoma from any jurisdiction in or outside the United States where I may be found and also agree that I will not contest any effort by any jurisdiction to return to the State of Oklahoma.

13. I understand that certain violations may result in the imposition of additional sanctions including, but not limited to:

- a. Financial Planning,
- b. Mental Health Counseling,
- c. Attend AA,
- d. Attend MRT,
- e. GED Courses,
- f. Reintegration Training,
- g. Intensive Supervision,
- h. Attend NA,
- i. Curfew,

- j. Intensive Parole Supervision,
- k. Electronic Monitoring,
- l. Community Service,
- m. Victim Impact Panel,
- n. Weekend Incarceration,
- o. Nighttime Incarceration,
- p. Day Reporting,
- q. Temporary Placement in a community correctional facility or jail for up to thirty (30) days.

_____ J. Serve _____ days in the _____ County Jail.

_____ L. Said defendant is to participate in the Victim Impact Panel or other program as ordered by the Court, scheduled for:
