AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to marriage and family; prohibiting the advertising of no-fault divorce kits; defining term; providing penalty; providing codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 250 of Title 43, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Every person who, by writing or printing, by circulars or letters, or in any other way advertises or publishes any account of any no-fault divorce kit or where it may be obtained, or in any way aiding or assisting the same, or adapted to induce persons to adventure therein, upon conviction thereof, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

B. For purposes of this section, "No-Fault Divorce Kit" means information explaining or draft documents capable of being used by persons seeking to obtain a divorce in this state. The term shall not include information or draft documents provided by an attorney or a court or clerk of the court for the purpose of assisting a person in obtaining a divorce.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1998.
