AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state employees; providing bonuses for certain employees; providing for noncodification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. Effective July 1, 1998, all classified and unclassified employees who are in professional-level data processing jobs with the state shall be eligible for a bonus of _____ Dollars (\$_____.00) if the employee remains in that job until January 1, 2000.

Bonuses granted to employees pursuant to this section shall be posted after any and all other salary transactions for such employees.

SECTION 2. NONCODIFICATION Section 1 of this act shall not be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1998.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
