AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution relating to ethics; encouraging the Ethics Commission to amend the Rules of the Ethics Commission to prohibit anonymous contributions; and providing for distribution.

WHEREAS, the Ethics Commission was constitutionally created in 1990 to promulgate rules of ethical conduct for campaigns and investigate, fine and prosecute violations of such rules; and

WHEREAS, the Ethics Commission is responsible for the promulgation, repeal, and modification of rules of ethical conduct for campaigns for state office pursuant to Article 29, Section 3 of the Oklahoma Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the Rules of the Ethics Commission currently permit a person to make and a committee to accept anonymous contributions not to exceed Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 46TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives encourages the Ethics Commission to amend the Rules of the Ethics Commission to prohibit all anonymous contributions, while still allowing cash contributions

not to exceed Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) during a campaign as long as the contributor fills out a contributor's statement.

THAT copies of this resolution shall be distributed to the members of the Ethics Commission and the Executive Director of the Ethics Commission.
