AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution designating The 145th Army Band as  
"The Governor's Own"; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, while in office, Governor George Nigh unofficially  
declared The 145th Army Band of the Oklahoma Army National Guard,  
"The Governor's Own"; and

WHEREAS, the members of The 145th Army Band have taken great  
pride in this title and would like to see it designated an official  
and permanent title; and

WHEREAS, most of the members of The 145th Army Band have fifteen  
to twenty years or more in the military, and as members of this  
unit; and

WHEREAS, Oklahomans take great pride in the spirit of the men  
and women who serve their country and their state, and feel that  
pride at an even higher level while listening to the music of the  
military bands performing in the different communities and events in  
this state.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 46TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE  
CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT The 145th Army Band of the Oklahoma Army National Guard be  
hereby designated for all time, "The Governor's Own".

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to the Governor,  
and to the Department of the Army, 145th Army Band.
