AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution memorializing Congress to direct the United States Consumer Product Safety Commission to adopt an industry standard for bunk beds; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the United States Consumer Product Safety Commission attempts to warn consumers of bunk beds of entrapment hazards and mattress support collapse; and

WHEREAS, several young children have died as a result of these hazards; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that consumers of these bunk beds be alerted to the hazards by more specific warnings issued by the United States Consumer Product Safety Commission; and

WHEREAS, it is also necessary for retailers of bunk beds to either discontinue selling the hazardous bunk beds or make those which are considered hazardous by the United States Consumer Product Safety Commission safe in accordance with the Commission's guidelines.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 46TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE
CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma Legislature memorializes Congress to direct
the United States Consumer Product Safety Commission to adopt an
industry standard for bunk beds.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to the President
of the United States, the Clerk of the United States House of
Representatives, the Secretary of the United States Senate, and each
member of the Oklahoma Congressional Delegation.
