AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution mourning the loss of Jack Yoakum; extending condolences; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Jack Yoakum was born in Muldrow, Oklahoma, March 28, 1937. Jack Yoakum was the Chief Executive Officer of the Bank of Commerce in Chouteau, Oklahoma, at the time of his death; and

WHEREAS, Jack Yoakum began his career in the banking industry in Tulsa, Oklahoma, in the 1950's at Commercial Credit and from there was employed at Northside State Bank from 1959 until 1962; and

WHEREAS, Jack Yoakum, in 1962, worked at Merchant's National Bank in Fort Smith, Arkansas, and then worked at the Bank of Locust Grove from 1973 until 1989. Jack Yoakum was also an Oklahoma state bank examiner from 1970 until 1973. With all his experience Jack Yoakum was considered an authority and expert by the banking community. He was the current director of the Oklahoma Bankers Association; and

WHEREAS, Jack Yoakum served his state and local community through a variety of civic and local organizations. In his early years in Muldrow, he helped organize the first youth baseball club. Many honors were given to Jack Yoakum in recognition of his loving and giving heart; and

WHEREAS, Jack Yoakum served on the Board of Directors of Mayes County Medical Center and was the vice-president of economic development for the Chouteau Chamber of Commerce. He served on the board of directors of the Grand River Dam Authority from 1989 until 1998, serving as chairman in 1993.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 46TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Legislature mourns the loss of Jack Yoakum.

THAT the Legislature extends sincere and heartfelt condolences to Jack Yoakum's family on behalf of the citizens of this state.
