AS INTRODUCED

A Joint Resolution relating to schools; requesting an investigation of the Oklahoma State School Board Association for certain purpose; requiring the filing of a report; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma State School Board Association is an association which represents the different school boards in this state on issues affecting the common schools of this state; and

WHEREAS, it is alleged that state funds are utilized by the Association; and

WHEREAS, it is imperative that the state and the people of this state are aware of how all state funds are used; and

WHEREAS, the Governor has the authority to appoint an independent counsel to investigate matters in this state, including those involving the expenditure of public funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 46TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Governor appoint and fund an independent counsel to investigate the Oklahoma State School Board Association to determine any use of state funds from January 1, 1990 to December 31, 1997.

THAT on or before February 1, 1998, a report of the investigation and its findings be filed with the Governor, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the President Pro Tempore

of the Senate, the State Superintendent of Public Instruction, and each member of the State Board of Education.

THAT a copy of this resolution shall be distributed to the Executive Director of the Oklahoma State School Board Association, the Governor, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the State Superintendent of Public Instruction, and each member of the State Board of Education.
