HOUSE JOINT  
RESOLUTION NO. 1080

AS INTRODUCED

A Joint Resolution directing the Administrator of the Office of Personnel Management to conduct a study of certain personnel policies and practices used by state agencies;; requiring recommendations; and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, state agencies that are subject to the Merit System of Personnel Administration have established a variety of agency-specific policies and procedures related to interagency transfers and promotions that affect state employees; and

WHEREAS, state agencies in all branches of state government have established a variety of agency-specific systems and policies related to time and attendance that affect state employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 46TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. A. The Administrator of the Office of Personnel Management shall study the policies and practiced used by state agencies in regard to interagency transfers, promotions, leave, and attendance, including the use of the time and attendance system of the Office of Personnel Management.

B. The Administrator of the Office of Personnel Management shall submit recommendations pursuant to this section to the Governor, the Speaker of the House of Representative, and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate by December 1, 1998.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
