AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution relating to House Rules; amending House Rule 8 of the 46th Oklahoma Legislature by adding a new Section 10, which relates to priority measures; and providing for the designation of preference measures and procedures and requirements related thereto.

SECTION 1. House Rule 8 of the 46th Oklahoma Legislature is amended by adding a new Section 10, to read as follows:

Section 10: Priority Measures.

(a) Each member may designate not to exceed five (5) measures of which the member is the principal author as priority measures. Any measure designated as a priority measure shall be considered by a vote of the committee to which it is assigned prior to the date specified in Joint Rule 17 for reporting measures from committee in the house of origin.

(b) Designations of priority measures must be filed, in writing, with the Chief Clerk prior to the third legislative day in sessions held in odd-numbered years and the second legislative day in sessions held in even-numbered years. The Chief Clerk shall not accept any new or changed designations after the dates specified in this paragraph.

(c) The Chief Clerk shall notify each committee chair of any priority measures that have been assigned to the chair's committee.
