AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution relating to Boys and Girls Club organizations; proclaiming National Boys and Girls Club Week; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Boys and Girls Club organizations of Oklahoma and the State of Oklahoma will recognize National Boys and Girls Club Week, an observance shared by 2,013 Boys and Girls Clubs and 2.8 million youth across the United States, on April 19 through April 25, 1998; and

WHEREAS, there are 19 Boys and Girls Club organizations in Oklahoma, providing services to more than 100,000 young people annually; and

WHEREAS, the Boys and Girls Club organizations are at the forefront of efforts in substance abuse prevention, teen sexual activity prevention, delinquency prevention, day care and, in some cases, literacy programs; and

WHEREAS, the Boys and Girls Club organizations in our state help ensure that our young people keep off the streets, offering them a safe and positive place to go and providing quality programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 46TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives does hereby proclaim
April 19 through April 25, 1998, as National Boys and Girls Club
Week in the State of Oklahoma and calls all citizens to join in
recognizing the Boys and Girls Clubs in our state for providing
comprehensive services to the young people in our communities.

THAT copies of this resolution shall be distributed to the
McCurtain County Boys and Girls Club of the Choctaw Nation and the
Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma.
