AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department; directing the transfer of funds; stating purpose; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

OKLAHOMA TOURISM AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT

SECTION 1. The Attorney General is hereby directed to transfer to the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department the amount of One Hundred Four Thousand Two Hundred Eleven Dollars and fifty-eight cents (\$154,211.58) of the original appropriation of Three Hundred Eighty-eight Thousand Dollars (\$388,000.00), appropriated to the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department by Section 54, Chapter 320, O.S.L. 1988, for the purpose of matching federal funds appropriated by the 1988 Energy and Water Development Appropriations Bill to construct a Water Resource and Tourism Information Center for the Red and Arkansas River Basins. Such transferred funds shall be used for the purpose of completing construction of the conference center at Robbers Cave State Park. If, on the effective date of this act, any of the originally appropriated funds, as adjusted by expenditures, encumbrances and transfers, result in an unencumbered balance less than the above amount to be transferred, such amount shall be reduced to the unencumbered balance.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1998.
