SENATE BILL NO. 1112

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state employees; providing duties of Administrator of the Office of Personnel Management; mandating Administrator implement grade adjustments for certain classes; providing salary increase for certain employees; requiring posting of salary adjustments; limiting other salary increases; prohibiting reduction of salary increase; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 840-2.17A of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Administrator of the Office of Personnel Management shall consult with agencies that would be affected by assigning higher grades to certain Merit System data processing classes pursuant to recommendations in the 1998 Annual Compensation Report published by the Office of Personnel Management.

B. Effective July 1, 1998, the Administrator shall implement the grade adjustments for classes as listed in the data processing grade change report published by the Office of Personnel Management.

C. Effective July 1, 1998, the base salaries of classified employees in data processing classes assigned to a higher grade

pursuant to subsection B of this section shall be increased by ___% of each employee's June 30, 1998, base salary.

D. Appointing authorities of unclassified employees in data processing jobs that are covered by the description of a class assigned to a higher grade pursuant to subsection B of this section shall increase the base salaries of such employees effective July 1, 1998. The amount of such increase shall be ___% of each employee's June 30, 1998, base salary.

E. Salary increases granted to employees pursuant to this section shall be posted after any and all other salary transactions for such employees. Employees receiving any salary increase pursuant to this section shall not be eligible for the general salary increase. Provided further, the ___% increase authorized pursuant to subsections C and D shall not be reduced or eliminated if it causes an employee's salary to exceed the maximum rate for a grade.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
