AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state facility administration;
making an appropriation to the Department of
Central Services; stating purpose; authorizing
certain expenditures; exempting certain
expenditures from budgetary limitations; providing
for duties and compensation of employees; limiting
salary of the Director; providing for budgetary and
category limitations; making an appropriation to
the Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority; stating
purpose; authorizing certain budgeting of
appropriations; providing lapse date; and providing
an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

DEPARTMENT OF CENTRAL SERVICES

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of
Central Services from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
ending June 30, 1998, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or
so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
upon the Department of Central Services by law.

SECTION 2. The Department of Central Services is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary from the Risk Management Participation Revolving Fund created pursuant to Section 85.34B of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes to provide such salaries and administrative expenses as required by the Comprehensive Professional Risk Management Program provided for in Section 85.34 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 3. The Department of Central Services is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary from the Oklahoma Motor License Agent Indemnity Fund created pursuant to Section 1143.1 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes to provide such salaries and administrative expenses as required by the Comprehensive Professional Risk Management Program provided for in Section 85.34 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 4. Expenditures from the Risk Management Revolving Fund shall not be subject to the budgetary limitations established for the Department of Central Services in Section 6 of this act. Payment of claims from the Risk Management Revolving Fund, Oklahoma Motor License Agent Indemnity Fund, Risk Management Participation Revolving Fund, and Risk Management Elderly and Handicapped Transportation Revolving Fund shall not be subject to the budgetary limitations established for the Department of Central Services in Section 6 of this act.

SECTION 5. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Central Services by law shall be set by the Director of the Department of Central Services. The salary of the Director shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998. The Department of Central Services for the fiscal year ending June 30,

1998, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures, excluding expenditures for capital, intra-agency payments and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

OKLAHOMA CAPITOL IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY

SECTION 7. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purpose of

retiring bonds issued by the Authority for capital improvements to the Capitol buildings.

SECTION 8. Appropriations made by this act, not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998 (hereafter FY-98) or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999 (hereafter FY-99). Funds budgeted for FY-98 may be encumbered only through June 30, 1998, and must be expended by November 15, 1998. Any funds remaining after November 15, 1998, and not budgeted for FY-99, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-99 may be encumbered only through June 30, 1999. Any funds remaining after November 15, 1999, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-98, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-99, after the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared and submitted a budgeted work program revision removing these funds from the FY-98 budget work program and after such revision has been approved by the Office of State Finance.

SECTION 9. This act shall become effective September 1, 1997.
