AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Historical Society;
providing for duties and compensation of employees;
limiting the salary of the Director and Deputy
Executive Director; providing budgetary limitation;
requiring budgeting of certain funds in certain
categories and amounts; and providing an effective
date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

OKLAHOMA HISTORICAL SOCIETY

SECTION 1. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Historical Society by law shall be set by the Director of the Oklahoma Historical Society. The salary of the Director shall not exceed Fifty-eight Thousand Six Hundred Eleven Dollars (\$58,611.00) per annum and the salary of the Deputy Executive Director shall not exceed Fifty-three Thousand Five Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$53,550.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998. The Oklahoma Historical Society for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent

employees and expenditures, excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998, the Oklahoma Historical Society shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:
