AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to prisons and reformatories;
authorizing the Department of Corrections to
dispose of real property; requiring certain sale
procedures; authorizing the use of sale proceeds
for equipment and training; providing for
noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. The Department of Corrections is hereby authorized to dispose of the real property located at 1411 Classen Drive in Oklahoma City, County of Oklahoma, State of Oklahoma, the legal description of which is as follows: All of lots one (1) through twelve (12) and twenty-one (21) through forty (40), Shields Heights Subdivision, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma.

Such property shall be disposed of pursuant to the provisions of Section 129.4 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes provided, notwithstanding any other provision of law, all monies received from the sale or disposal of said property, except those monies necessary to pay the expenses incurred pursuant to such sale, shall be deposited in the Department of Corrections Revolving Fund for the sole purpose of providing critical safety and security equipment and

CLEET certification training for correctional officers employed by the Department of Corrections.

SECTION 2. The provisions of Section 1 of this act shall not be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
