AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the J.M. Davis Memorial

Commission; providing for duties and compensation
of employees; limiting the salary of the Chief
Administrative Officer; providing budgetary
limitations; requiring all funds be budgeted in
certain categories and amounts; and providing an
effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. The duties and compensation of employees, not
otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
upon the J.M. Davis Memorial Commission by law shall be set by the
the Chief Administrative Officer of the J.M. Davis Memorial
Commission. The salary of the Director shall not exceed Forty-four
Thousand Three Hundred Eighty-four Dollars (\$44,384.00) per annum,
payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998. The J.M.
Davis Memorial Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998,
shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-
time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures

for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998, the J.M. Davis Memorial Commission shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:
