AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state employees; requiring certain reimbursements to state employees; specifying reimbursable expenditures; requiring documentation; providing for codification; providing for an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5.19 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

State employees who are required by their employer to remain on duty after their normal work day shall be reimbursed for any additional expenses that they incur as a result of their obligation to remain at their duty station. Expenses that shall be reimbursed include, but are not limited to, child care and transportation. Proper documentation must be submitted and approved by the employer.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1998.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
