SENATE BILL NO. 1254

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public employees; granting pay increase to certain allied health classification employees; providing for noncodification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. All full-time employees of the state in the allied health classifications not currently covered under a special payline and who did not receive a ten percent (10%) increase in base pay pursuant to Section 4, Chapter 300, O.S.L. 1996, shall be awarded a salary increase of ten percent (10%) in base pay effective July 1, 1998.

SECTION 2. The provisions of Section 1 of this act shall not be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1998.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
