AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries;
creating the Oklahoma Beautification through
Outdoor Advertising Rehabilitation and Diminishment
Act; providing short title; providing for
codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1286 of Title 69, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma
Beautification through Outdoor Advertising Rehabilitation and
Diminishment Act", and may also be cited as the "OK Board Act".

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
