SHORT TITLE: Poor persons; amending the state Medicaid plan to require certain coverage. Effective date.

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to poor persons; requiring the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to provide certain coverage under the state Medicaid plan; requiring submission of certain waiver for certain purpose; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1010.11 of Title 56, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Effective December 1, 1998, the Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall provide coverage under the state Medicaid plan for physician directed and physician supervised treatment for smoking cessation, pursuant to a waiver approved by the federal Health Care Financing Administration.

B. The Authority shall submit to the federal Health Care Financing Administration, on or before October 1, 1998, an application for any waivers required to amend the state Medicaid plan to enact the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1998.
