AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Department of Environmental
Quality; providing for duties and compensation of
employees; limiting salary of Executive Director;
providing budget category limitations; and
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY

SECTION 1. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Environmental Quality by law shall be set by the Executive Director. The salary of the Executive Director shall not exceed Seventy-two Thousand Dollars (\$72,000.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998. The Department of Environmental Quality, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures, excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998, the Department of Environmental Quality shall budget all funds for the programs and services and currently authorized new services in the following categories and amounts:
