AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Human Rights

Commission; providing for duties and compensation
of employees of the Human Rights Commission;
limiting the salary of the Director and number of
full-time-equivalent employees; providing budgetary
limitations; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

OKLAHOMA HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION

SECTION 1. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Human Rights Commission by law shall be set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed Fifty Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$50,200.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998. The Oklahoma Human Rights Commission, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1997.
