AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education; stating legislative intent relating to the appropriation of certain monies for supplements for certain graduate fellowships targeted to certain areas of excellence; and providing for noncodification.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. It is the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature that Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) be appropriated to the State Regents for Higher Education for the purpose of providing fifty (50) supplements of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) each to graduate fellowships offered by Oklahoma Colleges and Universities targeted to certain areas of excellence under plans approved by the State Regents for Higher Education.

SECTION 2. The provisions of Section 1 of this act shall not be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes.
