AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to criminal procedure; requiring district attorney to notify school district upon filing charges against district employee; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 451.2 of Title 22, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Upon filing an information or indictment, if the district attorney is aware that the defendant is an employee of a school district, the district attorney shall notify the superintendent of the district of the charges filed against the employee.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1998.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
