AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Capitol Improvement

Authority; making an appropriation; stating
purpose; providing lapse date; and providing an
effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purpose of retiring bonds issued by the Authority for capital improvements to the Capitol buildings.

SECTION 2. The appropriation made by this act shall be subject to fiscal year limitations and may be encumbered through June 30, 1998. Any unexpended funds remaining after November 15, 1998, shall lapse and be transferred to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective September 1, 1997.
