AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Department of Central Services; providing for duties and compensation of employees; limiting salary of the Director; providing budgetary limitations; requiring all funds to be budgeted in certain categories and amounts; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Central Services by law shall be set by the Director of the Department of Central Services. The salary of the Director shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998. The Department of Central Services for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures, excluding expenditures for capital, intra-agency payments and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
