AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to supplemental appropriations;

making an appropriation to the Department of
Corrections; stating purpose; amending Sections 3
and 4, Chapter 267, O.S.L. 1996, which relate to
budgeting of all funds in certain categories and
budgetary limits of the Department of Corrections;
modifying certain budget category limits, number of
full-time-equivalent employees, and lease-purchase
agreement amount; making certain appropriation
nonfiscal; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of
Corrections from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
ending June 30, 1996, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much
thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the
Department of Corrections by law.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY Section 3, Chapter 267, O.S.L. 1996, is amended to read as follows:

Section 3. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, the Department of Corrections shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

SECTION 3. AMENDATORY Section 4, Chapter 267, O.S.L. 1996, is amended to read as follows:

Section 4. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Corrections by law shall be set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed Seventy-four Thousand One Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$74,180.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997. The Department of Corrections for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 4. The appropriation made by Section 1 of this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
