AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to supplemental appropriations;

making an appropriation to the Oklahoma Indigent
Defense System; stating purpose; making certain
appropriation nonfiscal; providing lapse dates;
providing certain budgeting restrictions; and
declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

INDIGENT DEFENSE SYSTEM

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma
Indigent Defense System from any monies not otherwise appropriated
from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal
year ending June 30, 1996, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so
much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon
the Oklahoma Indigent Defense System by law.

SECTION 2. The appropriation made by this act, but not
including appropriation made for capital outlay purposes, may be
budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997 (hereafter FY-97),
or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998
(hereafter FY-98). Funds budgeted for FY-97 may be encumbered only
through June 30, 1997, and must be expended by November 15, 1997.
Any funds remaining after November 15, 1997, and not budgeted for

FY-98, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-98 may be encumbered only through June 30, 1998. Any funds remaining after November 15, 1998, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-97, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-98, after the agency has prepared and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds from the FY-97 budget work program and after such revision has been approved by the Office of State Finance.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
