AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Commission for
Teacher Preparation; authorizing a National Board
Certification program for teachers; providing for
codification; providing an effective date; and
declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-203 of Title 70, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Subject to the availability of funds, the Oklahoma Commission
for Teacher Preparation shall have authority to establish a program
to assist teachers seeking National Board Certification. The
Commission, prior to offering any assistance, shall promulgate rules
relating to the administering of the program.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1997.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared
to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in
full force from and after its passage and approval.
