AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the militia; amending 44 O.S.

1991, Section 232.5, which relates to assignment of military organizations to armories; clarifying statutory reference; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 44 O.S. 1991, Section 232.5, is amended to read as follows:

Section 232.5 The Adjutant General shall assign military organizations to the various armories. Armories are provided primarily for the use and benefit of the military organizations quartered therein, but nothing in ~~this act~~ Section 232.1 et seq. of this title shall be construed as prohibiting the use of any armory building by any educational, civic, religious, patriotic, or veterans organization, or for the purpose of holding athletic or social events, or meetings under the auspices of any recognized political party, or use by any governmental agency, provided such use is temporary and does not in any way interfere with requirements of the state, and provided no expense to the Military Department of the state is incurred by reason of such use. No armory building or other facilities enumerated in Section ~~1 of this act~~ 232.1 of this title may be used for other than military purposes except under lease as hereinafter provided.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1997.
