AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state government; authorizing certain discount at state owned parks and lodges; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1807.1 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

All full-time state employees shall receive a ten percent (10%) discount on food and lodging at state owned parks and lodges.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
