

SHORT TITLE: Roads, bridges and ferries; creating the Oklahoma Department of Transportation Advisory Commission; codification; effective date.

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries;

creating the Oklahoma Department of Transportation

Advisory Commission; providing for membership;

specifying powers and duties; providing for

codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA: SECTION 1.

NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 301.1 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. There is hereby created the Oklahoma Department of Transportation Advisory Commission. The Commission shall consist of the following members:

1. The Director of the Department of Transportation or designee;
2. The Chair of the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority or designee;
3. The Commissioner of the Department of Public Safety or designee;
4. The Chair of the Corporation Commission or designee;
5. The Director of the Oklahoma Trucking Association or designee; and

6. Four representatives selected by the Oklahoma Trucking Association subject to the approval of a majority of the members of the Commission.

B. Each member shall hold office for a two-year term or until the successor of the member takes office. The term of office shall begin on July 1 of the succeeding fiscal year. The Commission shall select a chair from among the members of the Commission each year. It shall be the duty of the Commission to act in an advisory capacity to the Director of the Department of Transportation. The Commission shall meet no less than on a quarterly basis with the Director of the Department of Transportation and the staff of the Director to discuss areas of mutual concern.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1997.
