AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to municipal and county officers and employees; prohibiting policies, rules and ordinances from placing certain burdens on municipal and county officers and employees; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24.5 of Title 51, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

No municipality or county may promulgate rules or adopt ordinances or policies that place a greater burden on a municipal or county officer or employee than the burden that is placed on any other person who acts to defend the person's family, home, or property.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
