

SHORT TITLE: Grand River Dam Authority; creating buffer zone to prohibit concentrated animal feedlot operations; codification; effective date; emergency.

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Grand River Dam Authority;

creating a buffer zone around certain waters;
prohibiting concentrated animal feeding operations
within buffer zone; providing for codification;
providing an effective date; and declaring an
emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 894 of Title 82, unless there is
created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, there is hereby
created a buffer zone extending from the shoreline of any waters of
the Grand River and its tributaries and extending inland a distance
of one-half (1/2) mile, such waters controlled by the Grand River
Dam Authority, pursuant to Section 861 et seq. of Title 82 of the
Oklahoma Statutes.

B. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, concentrated
animal feeding operations as defined by Section 9-202 of Title 2 of
the Oklahoma Statutes shall be prohibited within the buffer zone
established by subsection A of this section; provided, however, any
such feeding operation in existence prior to the effective date of
this act shall be exempt from the provisions of this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1997.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
