AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending
21 O.S. 1991, Section 906, which relates to obscene
language; clarifying statutory language; and
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 1991, Section 906, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 906. If any person shall utter or speak any obscene or
lascivious language or word in any public place, ~~or in the presence
of females,~~ or in the presence of children under ten (10) years of
age, he or she shall be liable ~~to~~ upon conviction for a fine of not
more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), or imprisonment for not
more than thirty (30) days, or both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1997.
