AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending Section 6, Chapter 143, O.S.L. 1995 (47 O.S. Supp. 1996, Section 230.26), which relates to contempt proceedings; clarifying statutory reference; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 6, Chapter 143, O.S.L. 1995 (47 O.S. Supp. 1996, Section 230.26), is amended to read as follows:

Section 230.26 When the Corporation Commission, upon complaint, has reason to believe that any person, motor carrier, or shipper is violating or has willfully violated any provision of the Motor Carrier Act of 1995, Section 230.21 et seq. of this title, the Commission shall, upon its own initiative, file a contempt proceeding and set a date for the proceeding to be heard before the Commission, and upon conviction the Commission shall invoke such contempt penalties as provided herein.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1997.
