AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; allowing travel reimbursement for certain students representing the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1210.402a of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Students who attend conferences and seminars as representatives of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics shall be reimbursed for necessary travel expenses as approved by the Board of Trustees, pursuant to the State Travel Reimbursement Act, Section 500.1, et seq. of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1997.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
