AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public health and safety; creating the Assisted Living Facilities Act; stating short title; providing for purpose; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-845.1 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Assisted Living Facilities Act".

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-845.2 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The State of Oklahoma, in enacting the Assisted Living Facilities Act, will contribute to the development of a comprehensive system of long-term care by enabling the establishment of community-based, assisted living facilities programs that provide a homelike environment for older persons and persons with developmental, physical or mental disabilities, or who need assistance with activities of daily living.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 1997.
