AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to Bogus Check Restitution Program;
amending 22 O.S. 1991, Section 113, which relates
to notice of complaint; providing for mailing to
last-known address; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 22 O.S. 1991, Section 113, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 113. A. Upon referral of a complaint to the Bogus
Check Restitution Program, a notice of the complaint shall be
forwarded by mail to the defendant at the last-known address.

B. The notice shall contain:

1. The date and amount of the check;
2. The name of the payee;
3. The date before which the defendant must contact the office
of the district attorney concerning the complaint; and
4. A statement of the penalty for obtaining money, merchandise
or services by means of a false and bogus check.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
