AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to counties and county officers;  
authorizing counties to participate in certain  
federal programs; providing for codification; and  
declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1.1 of Title 19, unless there is  
created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any county in this state may receive funds for and participate  
in any federal program, and may cooperate with the United States  
Government and any agency or instrumentality thereof, in the manner  
authorized and provided by federal law and regulation. In doing so,  
a county may perform all necessary functions and take all necessary  
actions for accomplishing such federal purposes and programs, as  
agent of the federal government, notwithstanding any provisions of  
state law.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
