AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to Council on Law Enforcement

Education and Training; amending Section 4, Chapter 389, O.S.L. 1992 (70 O.S. Supp. 1996, Section 3311.5), which relates to training of officers; clarifying language; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 4, Chapter 389, O.S.L. 1992 (70 O.S. Supp. 1996, Section 3311.5), is amended to read as follows:

Section 3311.5 ~~By September 1, 1992, the~~ The Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training, pursuant to its authority granted by Sections 3311 and 3311.4 of ~~Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title, shall include in its required courses of study for law enforcement certification a minimum of four (4) hours of education and training and at least one (1) hour of continuing law enforcement training relating to recognizing and managing a person appearing to require mental health treatment or services.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
