AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to elections; amending 26 O.S. 1991, Section 13-111, which relates to election expenses; eliminating gender distinction; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 1991, Section 13-111, is amended to read as follows:

Section 13-111. All expenses incurred in the conduct of any municipal election shall be paid by the municipality for which said election was held. Expenses shall include, but shall not be limited to, compensation for members of each precinct election board, per diem and mileage for the ~~chairman~~ chair and vice ~~chairman~~ chair of the county election board, the cost of supplies and ballots and the rental of polling places.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1997.
