AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to grand jury petitions; amending 38 O.S. 1991, Section 106, which relates to filing completed petition; adding statutory reference; clarifying language; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 38 O.S. 1991, Section 106, is amended to read as follows:

Section 106. Upon the obtaining of the signatures, and within the forty-five day time limitation provided in Section ~~3~~ 103 of this ~~act~~ title, the completed petitions shall be filed with the court clerk. The court clerk shall copy ~~said~~ the petitions and deliver the originals on the next business day, excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays, to the election board. Upon the delivery of ~~said~~ the petitions to the election board, the board shall have seven (7) business days, excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays, to determine how many of the signers of ~~said~~ the petitions are qualified electors within the county and shall return, not later than the seventh business day, excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays, the original petitions to the court clerk together with a certification of the number of such signers who are qualified electors within the county.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
