AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to managed care health plans;

requiring State Board of Health promulgate certain rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2508.2 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Pursuant to its authority to regulate managed care plans, the State Board of Health shall promulgate rules which shall require managed care plans to undergo periodic accreditation by the National Committee for Quality Assurance.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1997.
