AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to labor; amending 40 O.S. 1991, Section 88, which relates to penalties for violation of child labor laws; requiring violation be willful; deleting minimum fine; clarifying language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 40 O.S. 1991, Section 88, is amended to read as follows:

Section 88. A. Any person ~~violating~~ who is in willful violation of any of the provisions of ~~this article,~~ Section 71 et seq. of this title shall, upon conviction, be ~~punished by~~ guilty of a misdemeanor and, for each offense, shall be subject to a fine of not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or imprisonment in the county jail for not less than ten (10) nor more than thirty (30) days, or to both such fine and imprisonment.

B. It shall be the duty of the Commissioner of Labor to see that the provisions of ~~this article,~~ Section 71 et seq. of this title are enforced ~~with the exception of Section 85 of this title,~~ which shall be enforced by the Mine Inspector or under his direction.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1997.
