AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; amending Section 1, Chapter 150, O.S.L. 1994 (70 O.S. Supp. 1996, Section 5-103.1), which relates to elementary school districts; deleting obsolete language; modifying grade levels allowed for elementary districts; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 150, O.S.L. 1994 (70 O.S. Supp. 1996, Section 5-103.1), is amended to read as follows:

Section 103.1 ~~On or after the effective date of this act, except~~ Except upon approval of the State Board of Education, an elementary school district that did not offer any grade above the ~~eighth~~ sixth grade during the ~~1993-94~~ 1996-97 school year may not offer grades above the eighth grade during the ~~1994-95~~ 1997-98 school year or any school year thereafter. ~~No later than August 1, 1994, the~~ The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective on July 1, 1997.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
