

SHORT TITLE: Schools; requiring participation in the National Assessment of Education Progress; codification; emergency.

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; requiring participation in the National Assessment of Educational Progress; placing responsibility for the coordination of participation; describing responsibilities of participation; providing methods for conducting assessments; describing certain content to be included in the National Assessment of Educational Progress; providing instructions for publication; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1210.514 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The State Board of Education shall provide for school districts to participate in the administration of the National Assessment of Educational Progress for both the national sample and for any state-by-state comparison program which may be initiated. The assessment shall be conducted using the data collection procedures, student surveys, educator surveys and other instruments. The results of the assessment or assessments shall be included in the summary report of the Oklahoma Educational Indicators Program published pursuant to Section 1210.531 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1997.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
