

SHORT TITLE: Schools; providing notification for reemployment of school administrators; codification; emergency.

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to education; setting a date on reemployment of administrators; requiring special notification; setting salary limits; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-101a of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

If, prior to April 10, a board of education has not entered into a written contract with an administrator or notified the administrator in writing by registered or certified mail that a recommendation has been made not to reemploy the administrator for the ensuing fiscal year, and if, by April 25, said administrator has not notified the board of education in writing by registered or certified mail that said administrator does not desire to be reemployed in said school district for the ensuing year, said administrator shall be considered as employed on a continuing contract basis and on the same salary schedule used in the school district for the ensuing fiscal year, and such employment and continuing contract shall be binding on the administrator and on the school district.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1998.
